Report Card Conferences - Fri, Dec 7th - 9:00a-5:00p

Pre-Kindergarten – 5th Grade

ALL PARENTS are required to make an appointment and meet with your child's homeroom teacher to receive his/her report card.

Please contact Mrs. Smith to schedule an appointment on Dec 7th, between 9 AM and 5 PM. **Appointments will be 15 minutes in length** for each child. Please be on time for your appointment. If you miss your appointment, or find you cannot make the assigned time, please contact the office to re-schedule.

Middle School (6th – 8th Grade)

Due to the fact that Middle School students have multiple teachers, **all middle school teachers will be available to parents during conference times.** Please follow this process to receive your child's report card:

ALL PARENTS are required to attend parent-teacher conferences. Middle School Teachers will be located in the gym on December 7th, between 9 AM and 5 PM. **(Lunch break is 12:00 – 1:00, no teachers available.)**

Parents may come to the gym during these hours to meet with the homeroom teacher and receive your child's report card. Conferences will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. After you receive your child's report card, you may proceed to meet any other middle school teacher for questions/clarifications regarding your child's progress in a particular subject area.

We ask that you have your middle school student attend conferences with you so that there is clear communication about study habits, academic progress, and behavior between the student-teacher-parent.
