Read Across America— Reading to your child, could become a way to celebrate Dr. Seuss' birthday at home. Green Eggs and Ham anyone?

Did you know that a child who spends **20 minutes a day** reading will have read a total of **3,600 additional minutes** in a school year? By the time this child reaches 6th grade, that equals reading **1,800,000 additional words**? Students who read 20 minutes a day statistically do better in school due to increased vocabulary and comprehension.
